


INVASIVE AEDES

INDOOR MOSQUITO PROBLEM

Aedes aegypti (yellow fever) mosquitoes are one of the most widespread mosquitoes in the world. This mosquito is an invasive species to California. This opportunistic mosquito can thrive indoors and outdoors. Humans are the preferred host for these mosquitoes.



Keep doors and unscreened windows closed when not in use. Inspect to make sure they close properly without gaps.



Use screening to prevent access and regularly inspect screens for damage.



Some potential indoor breeding sources include: bromeliads, lucky bamboo, and other potted plants.
