Jurupa Valley High School provides a variety of academic programs including: Advanced Placement, AVID, and CTE programs in Agriculture & Natural Resources, Arts, Media & Entertainment, Construction, Engineering & Design, Information Technology, Manufacturing & Product Development, and Transportation.

CURRICULUM REQUIREMENTS

Students are required to complete 220 credits to graduate:

- 60 Credits: Electives
- 40 Credits: English
- 30 Credits: Math
- 20 Credits: Physical Education
- 10 Credits: World History, US History, Life Science, Physical Science, and LOTE or Fine Art
- 5 Credits: American Government, Economics, Healthy Living, and Vocational Art

Semester marking system gives 5 credits for every A, B, C, D earned. GPAs are based off the following marking system:

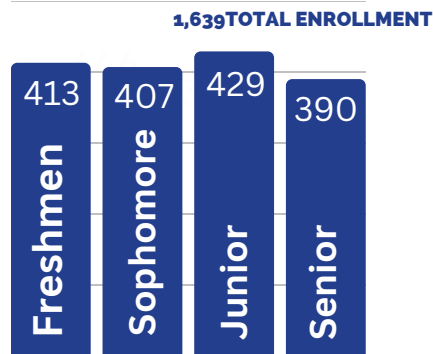
