## **INSTRUCTION**

## **SUBJECT: Graduation Requirements for Adult School**

A student shall earn a minimum of 175 credits in subjects above the eighth grade, as 1. follows:

| English                    | 40 credits  |

| Mathematics*               | 20 credits  |
| World Cultures             | 10 credits  |
| U.S. History               | 10 credits  |
| U.S. Government            | 5 credits   |
| Economics                  | 5 credits   |
| Science**                  | 20 credits  |
| Fine Arts/Foreign Language | 10 credits  |
| Electives                  | 55 credits  |
| TOTAL CREDITS              | 175 credits |

- A minimum of one year of Algebra meeting State standards.
- \*\* Science: Life Science – 10 credits; Physical Science – 10 credits
- 2. For the 2022-2023 school year only, students affected by the pandemic may utilize the California State Minimum High School Graduation Requirements.
- 3. Students must pass at least one mathematics course, or a combination of two mathematics courses, that meet or exceed state academic content standards for Algebra I. If any student completes coursework in grades 7 through 12 that meets or exceeds state academic content standards for algebra, those courses shall apply toward satisfying this mathematics requirement. (Education Code 51224.5) However, all students are required to take at least two years of mathematics in high school. (Education Code 51225.3)
- A minimum of 10 credits must be earned in the Jurupa Adult Education Program. 4.
- 5. Students 18 years of age or older may receive credit toward graduation by means of class attendance, credit granted for occupational work experience, credit granted for armed forces schools and/or programs.
