The following documents are required to enroll a student in the Jurupa Unified School District.

✓ **Verification of Parent/Guardian Identity**

Any one of the following items (with picture) is acceptable for the verification of identity.

- Current driver's license
- ID Card
- Bank ID
- Passport
- Company/work ID
- Foster Care/Care Giver Documentation

✓ **Verification of Student Birth Date**

Any one of the following items is acceptable for verification of date of birth:

- Original Birth Certificate
- Baptismal certificate duly attested
- Passport
- Adoption/Foster care Record
- Hospital Birth Record
- Notarized Affidavit of Parent/Guardian with Birth Date

✓ **Verification of Residency-ONLY** any one of the following will be accepted:

- Current Utility Bill (within 30 days)- Water/Light/Gas/Trash
- Current Mortgage Statement
- Escrow Papers/Rental Agreement

***IF RESIDING WITH ANOTHER FAMILY** we will need a current utility bill (within 30 days) in that person's name and the owner will also need to fill out and sign the Affidavit of Residency form.

✓ **Verification of Immunizations** (via the doctor's immunization record, yellow card/see CDPH link for appropriate dosage)

- Polio
- DTP (Diphtheria Tetanus & Pertussis)
- MMR (Measles or Rubeola, Mumps & Rubella)
- Hepatitis B
- Tdap
- Varicella (Chicken Pox) *

***Children who have had the disease need written documented clearance from their physician.**

✓ **Verification of Last School attended, Student Grades & Language Assessment**

- Transcript – Grades 7-12 (Request for Records sent by P/C to be delivered to Registrar at School Site)
- Last grade report card
- Withdrawal Documents
- CELDT/ELPAC Information

✓ **Original Physical Examination**

Required for all Kindergarten or 1st grade students. The physical exam must be given no earlier than six months prior to entry into kindergarten or no earlier than 18 months prior to the first day of 1st grade attendance at school. Also required for all students regardless of grade, entering from another country, and those who have resided in another state for more than one year.

- Oral Health Assessment – by May 31st of 1st year in public school
- Report of Health Examination for School Entry

✓ **Special Education Services**

- Current IEP for: SDC/RSP/504 Plan (If applicable)
