- 6. Prepares written reports of assessments administered. E
- Assists in the development of Individual Educational Programs for students with exceptional needs. E
- Re-evaluates students at least annually to determine appropriateness of placement and to ascertain progress. E
- Provides inservice training to parents and school employees in language, speech and hearing issues.
- Maintains a schedule which includes 80% direct instruction and/or collaboration, and 20% student assessment, coordination of Individualized Education Programs, and Student Study Team screenings.
- 11. Performs other related duties as assigned.
