FIRST STEPS

First Steps is our infant introductory program into home visitation. This year 17 previous graduates were able to move on and participate in ParentChild +. Another 18 families have graduated



the infant program totaling in 58 completed families since Feb. 2017. In total this program has served 77 infants.

PARENT-CHILD +

PCHP has become ParentChild+. Due to Funding from First 5 Riverside this program has more than tripled the number of families served. Graduating 10 children and parents from the two year program and completing year 1 with 29 families.







2018 - 2019

The first year of HIPPY is almost complete! In June the preschool aged program held graduation for the 28 four-year old's moving on to Kinder. As well as an end of year party for the 41 three-year old's moving on to the 2nd year of HIPPY. 28 families have completed the 30 week program, and an additional 44 families will be done in July.



Home visitation in Jurupa has expanded exponentially and exceeded its target goals for this year!

PRE-K STEM



Preschool children in Jurupa were able to participate in a brandnew parent involvement STEM program thanks to private funding from CyroWorks Inc. In spring 6 children and caregivers graduated with completion of both Level 1 (Explorers) and Level 2 (Pioneers).





DINOSAUR SCHOOL

This Social Emotional Learning program was provided to Jurupa families through Victor Community Support Services. In June PICO staff members were able to attend Dinosaur School Training and will now be provided this service directly to our community!



ABC MUSIC & ME

ABC Music & Me was the first parent-child interaction program offered by PICO and has now completed it's 4th year. Currently we offer classes for the entire span of 0-4 years old (infants, toddlers, twos, and preschool). Through our home visitation programs, we have been able to identify children who need additional support in communication and connect them to this early language and literacy program.
