JANUARY 10, 2025

Jurupa Valley, Patriot, and Rubidoux High Schools will be open until 3 p.m. today to assist families without power due to the continuing Southern California Edison Public Safety Power Shutoffs. Families are welcome to come to our high school campuses to relax in a safe space and charge Chromebooks and other devices.

JUSD is proud to offer this resource to our families. At this time, we also do plan to resume classes on Monday, January 13. We will share updates and/or schedule changes as needed.

JANUARY 12, 2025

Good afternoon, JUSD families:

We understand that recent fires, high winds, and Public Safety Power Shutoffs have caused significant concerns for our families. Additional high-wind events are forecast for next week. As a reminder, classes resume Monday, January 13, and at this time, we anticipate schools will be open and operating on the normal schedule. We are closely monitoring conditions and are in contact with emergency personnel and Southern California Edison officials and will share any updates or schedule changes should they become necessary.

We also understand that many of our families have been without power for the past several days due to the Public Safety Power Shutoffs. JANUARY 14, 2025

Good morning, JUSD families:

Power outages in our community continue today as strong Santa Ana winds persist across Southern California. Three of our campuses – Granite Hill, Mission Bell, and Peralta Elementary Schools – are currently without power. However, we have been able to bring in generators and portable lighting to allow learning to continue at those sites in a modified learning environment. At this time, all JUSD schools are open. We are closely monitoring the situation and are in contact with emergency personnel and Southern California Edison regarding possible additional impacts to our community. We will continue to update you as new information becomes available. Thank you for your continued support.
