NEW BUSINESS

1. President Burge changed the order of meeting to the first item under New Business on the agenda.

EMPLOYMENT OF SUPERINTENDENT

It was moved by Mr. Hughes and seconded by Mr. Johnson that Dr. Robert Edward Hummel be employed as Superintendent and secretary to the Governing Board of the Jurupa Unified School District for a four year term starting July 1, 1963 and ending June 30, 1967 subject to the terms and conditions set forth in contract number one for employment of Superintendent dated January 21, 1963 at a salary of \$16,000.00 a year.

INTRODUCTION

President Burge introduced Dr. Hummel, Superintendent of the Joint Union High School District, Kingsburg, California, giving a short resume of his background. Dr. Hummel, in turn, expressed his gratification at being elected to serve as Superintendent of the Jurupa Unified School District.

SHORT CONTRACT TERM

It was moved by Mr. Johnson and seconded by Mr. Hughes that Dr. Robert Edward Hummel be employed as Superintendent and secretary to the Governing Board of Jurupa Unified School District starting February 1, 1963 or as soon thereafter as possible and ending June 30, 1963 subject to the terms and conditions set forth in contract number two for employment of Superintendent dated January 21, 1963. The salary for this term will be prorated on the basis of \$16,000.00 a year.

MEETING OF ELEMENTARY BOARDS

1. Mr. Johnson reported concerning a joint meeting of elementary boards. He pointed out general topics for consideration, and suggested the date of meeting be left open for the convenience of the new superintendent. The meeting date will be set at the next board meeting.

CITIZENS' ADVISORY COMMITTEE

2. Mr. Gardner reported on the progress of the Citizens' Advisory Committee. The first meeting was called Thursday, January 17, 1963, and held in the Glen Avon School auditorium. Mr. John Correll was elected chairman, and Dr. Callis Herbert was elected secretary. Area chairman will be appointed to work with Mr. Correll. Mr. Gardner introduced Mr. Correll.

OLD BUSINESS

BOND ELECTION SPECIFICATIONS

1. Dr. Stallings presented for review a document stating legal specifications for district bond elections which was approved by the County Counsel. Correction of name, Anna instead of Donna, was made. Name of newspaper to be used for publishing of legal notices was discussed.

It was moved by Mr. Hughes and seconded by Mr. Gardner to use the Rubidoux Record for the publishing of legal notices.

2. Dr. Stallings reported that County Counsel was in the process of drawing up resolutions requesting bond elections be called, and they should be ready for approval at the regular meeting, February 4, 1963.

NEW BUSINESS

INTERNSHIP TEACHER PROGRAM

1. President Burge announced an internship program of secondary teachers set up by the University of California at Riverside. Seven candidates will be presented for interview as secondary teaching interns on February 6, 1963 at the university.

It was moved by Mr. Hughes and seconded by Mr. Gardner that the superintendent be instructed to interview these seven candidates on February 6, 1963.

ENROLLMENT PROJECTIONS

2. Dr. Stallings presented charts on enrollment projections for the board members to review. The projection indicates that the district will exceed 10,000 pupils by 1970.

MILEAGE ALLOWANCE

3. It was moved by Mr. Johnson and seconded by Mr. Pentland that mileage for travel expense on the basis of 8¢ per mile be allowed.

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There being no further business, it was moved by Mr. Johnson and seconded by Mr. Pentland to adjourn the meeting at 8:15 p.m.

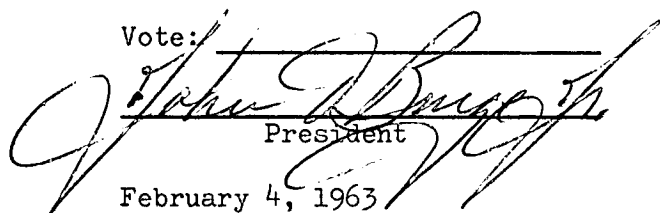

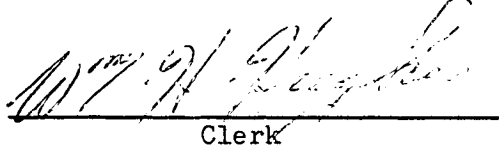
