Superintendent Hummel reported that the best available space at the least cost to the district, had been found at the Rustic Lane School. The tentative address for the district office will be 6420 Rustic Lane, Riverside, California

The Assistant Superintendent-Business Services is to be assigned after the screening of candidates has been completed. Mr. Ernest A. Miller was named Administrative Assistant to the Superintendent. Recommendations on employment of personnel for 1963-64 school year will be forwarded from Boards of Trustees of component school districts in order that they might be reviewed by the Jurupa Unified School Board of Trustees at their March 18 Meeting.
