ORDER CALLING BONDED
INDEBTEDNESS ASSUMPTION ELECTION

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by Leonard Grindstaff, County Superintendent of Schools of Riverside County, California, pursuant to the request of the governing body of the Jurupa Unified School District and the provisions of law as stated in Section 2890 of the Education Code of the State of California, that an election is hereby called in the Jurupa Unified School District of Riverside and San Bernardino Counties, California, at which election there will be submitted to the electors of said district the question of whether or not said unified school district shall assume the outstanding bonded indebtedness of the Glen Avon, Pedley and West Riverside School Districts of Riverside County and the Union Joint School District of Riverside and San Bernardino Counties, which said elementary school districts are included within the Jurupa Unified School District, and the proportionate share of the outstanding bonded indebtedness of the Riverside City Joint High School District of Riverside and San Bernardino Counties, as of July 1, 1963.


