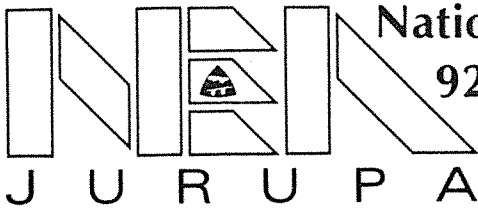
ACTION SESSION




TENTATIVE AGREEMENT

January 21, 1993

The Parties agree to the following:

1. All tentative agreements as previously agreed.
2. The current (1991-92) salary schedule shall be effective July 1, 1992.
3. The 1990/91 salary schedule, which was six percent (6%) less than the current salary schedule, shall be effective February 1, 1993.
 - a. If the unaudited or audited actual unrestricted ending balance (Object 9710 and 9790, Column A, form J201) for 1992-93 is less than four percent (4%), at its option the District may reopen negotiations on the 1993-94 Basic Certificated Salary Schedule.
 - b. If the unaudited or audited actual unrestricted ending balance (Object 9710 and 9790, Column A, form J201) for 1992-93 is four percent (4%) or more but less than five percent (5%), then the Basic Certificated Salary Schedule shall remain in effect through the end of the 1993-94 school year unless otherwise modified by mutual agreement of the parties.
 - c. The District shall have the option to reopen negotiations on the Basic Certificated Salary Schedule for 1993-94 if the State of California reduces total district unrestricted revenues per ADA (which currently includes but is not limited to \$3100.63 BRL/ADA exclusive of lottery) for 1993-94 to an amount less than received in 1992-93 (exclusive of the supplemental grant add-on), and if the State of California does not provide authority to the District to offset the loss of revenue from other state and/or local sources. It is not the intent of the parties to require the District to reduce or eliminate any existing district program. The District further agrees that it will not use any unrestricted revenues for any non-mandated categorical program (except Home-to-School Transportation) or special reserve fund during the 1992-93 school year.

- d. If the unaudited or audited actual unrestricted ending balance (Object 9710 and 9790, Column A, Form J201) for 1992-93 is more than five percent (5%), then the District shall restore three percent (3%) to the Basic Certificated Salary Schedule effective July 1, 1993, and either side at its option may reopen negotiations on the Basic Certificated Salary Schedule for 1993/94.
- e. The District shall not augment any existing district program with unrestricted revenues during the 1992-93 school year.
4. The parties express their mutual intent to restore teachers' salaries to the current level (i.e., that in effect July 1, 1992) as soon as practicable.
5. The parties shall establish a joint committee to review the District's budget for the purpose of making recommendations to the parties and to the Board for future efficiencies, cost savings, and expenditure reductions.
6. In the event that either management or classified receive an increase in health and welfare benefits or compensation through salary schedule adjustment or bonus in 1992-93 school year greater than that provided herein, certificated bargaining unit members shall receive the same increase. This provision shall remain in effect for the 1993-94 school year in the event that negotiations on the Basic Certificated Salary Schedule are not reopened for that year.
