

Resolution #2007/30 OPPOSING THE SALE OF ALCOHOL IN CLOSE PROXIMITY TO SCHOOL SITES

WHEREAS, children have a right to attend school in a safe and secure environment; and

WHEREAS, the use of alcohol in the proximity of a school site can endanger children; and

WHEREAS, the law in the State of California prohibits the sale of alcohol from being sold within 600 feet of a school premise; and

WHEREAS, a liquor license is being applied for by a business at a distance slightly more than 1,000 feet from a school site; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Jurupa Unified School District believes that this distance still endangers students going to and from school; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of the Jurupa Unified School District officially opposes the granting of a license to add liquor sales to an existing mini-mart located on the corner of Pacific Avenue and Mission Boulevard, which is within the close proximity of Rubidoux High School.
