MOMENT OF SILENCE

RECOGNITION

1. Dr. Hansen reported that the State Office of Public-School Construction recently notified the district that grant funding for three School Facility Program applications has been awarded as follows:

1. Rubidoux High School Career Technical Education Facilities Program (CTEFP): Production & Managerial Arts Pathway in the amount of \$122,769.00
2. Jurupa Valley High School Career Technical Education Facilities Program (CTEFP): Residential & Commercial Construction Pathway in the amount of \$77,576.00
3. Mission Bell Elementary School Modernization Project in the amount of \$1,609,860.00

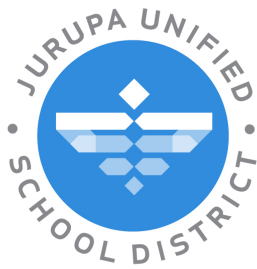
Sky Country PTO donated \$610.94 to purchase Face Masks for Sky County Elementary.

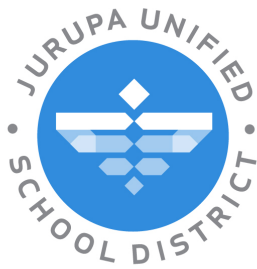
