RECOGNITIONS

- The State Office of Public School Construction notified the district that grant funding for one School Facility Program application had been awarded to Glen Avon Elementary School New Construction in the amount of \$861,327.00

ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS

- The State Board of Education approved standards for the local indicators included in the Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) that support districts in measuring and reporting their progress within the local priority areas. These approved standards require the district to annually measure its progress and report the results of these indicators to the governing board. We will be addressing our annual progress on five local performance indicators as follows:
