- The State Department of Education notified the district that funding for the After School Education and Safety (ASES) Program has been awarded in the amount of \$2,550,514.49. This program will be conducted at Glen Avon, Granite Hill, Ina Arbuckle, Mission Bell, Pacific Avenue, Pedley, Peralta, Rustic Lane, Sky Country, Stone Avenue, Sunnyslope, Troth Street, Van Buren and West Riverside Elementary School and Jurupa, Mira Loma and Mission Middle School.
- The State Department of Education has notified the district it will receive funds as part of the 2023/2024 Agricultural Career Technical Education Incentive Grant Program. Jurupa Valley High School will receive \$13,679 and Rubidoux High School will receive \$19,096, for a total grant award of \$32,775.
- The district was recently notified that Mission Middle School has been awarded the Project Lead The Way (PLTW) grant in the amount of \$10,000.

- The Riverside County Office of Education notified the District that the 2023/2024 First Interim Financial Report has received positive certification and that they have notified the California Department of Education accordingly.

Senate Bill 114 (2023) added a requirement for LEAs to present a report on the annual update to the Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) and Budget Overview for Parents (BOP) on or before February 28 each at a regularly scheduled meeting of the governing board or body of the LEA.
