

BOARD BYLAWS

SUBJECT: District Group Insurance Programs - Board of Education

Members of the Board of Education may participate in one each of any type of district group insurance plan available to employees. District cost for any Board member shall be limited to the maximum health and welfare benefit available to members of any employee group. Coverage may be on an individual, two-party or family basis except for limitations set forth by an insurance carrier. Board members would be required to contribute to any cost that exceeds the Health and Welfare benefit available to them.

Board members may continue to participate in health, dental, life or other insurance programs available to employees of the school district, and for which they qualify at their own expense under current Federal and State COBRA laws.
