All lease-leaseback prime contractors and mechanical, electrical and plumbing ("MEP") subcontractors (as defined in Public Contract Code section 20111.6) must be prequalified with the District. Lease-Leaseback contractors must submit their prequalification application via QualityBidders.com on or before **September 23, 2025, at 5:00 p.m.**.

A mandatory job walk/conference is scheduled for **September 18, 2025, at 10:30a.m.**. Please meet at Rustic Lane Elementary School, 6420 Rustic Lane, Jurupa Valley, CA 92509. Any proposer who fails to attend the entire mandatory job walk and conference will be deemed non-responsive bidder and will have its proposal unopened and returned.

Pursuant to California Labor Code Sections 1720 et seq., it shall be mandatory upon the contractor and all subcontractors to pay not less than the general prevailing rate of per diem wages in the locality in which this work is to be performed for each craft or type of worker needed to execute the contract, including holiday and overtime work as well as employer payments for health and welfare, pension, vacation, and similar purposes.
