Library Access through Follett Destiny® Search

EBSCO Publishing

Access online databases of over 1000 full-text periodicals, journals, and magazines; full-text newspapers, education journals, biographies, primary source documents, and reference books. Additional resources include: a language translation feature and over 11,000 downloadable images. (Requires User ID and Password)

World Book Online (WBO)

Searching for updated reference sources on the Internet is simple with WBO. WBO provides access to the complete 22-volume print set, plus over 3,700 additional articles. With the click of a mouse, students can visit related web sites, view videos, images, and maps.

HOW TO ACCESS THE DESTINY® SEARCH (LIBRARY SEARCH)

(Accessible Inside and Outside JUSD)

Step 1: Launch Internet Explorer



View library holdings from the convenience of home or the classroom.

Step 2: Open the JUSD home page:
<http://www.jusd.k12.ca.us>

Step 3: Point to Online Resources and **Select** Library Resources

Step 4: Click on JUSD Library Search, then

select the School Library Media Center link

Step 5: Select your school

Step 6: Select the Catalog tab

Step 7: Type in your search criteria and **select** the appropriate search icon (author, title, subject, keyword). *Note: To search by reading levels use the Search Reading Programs and select the Lexile® or AR® search.*

Step 8: At the result list **select** a title to view details.

Step 9: To add a title to *My List*, **click** on Add to My List. One book will be added. Continue to search and add items to *My List* as needed. When complete you can print your selected items.

Step 10: To print your *My List*, **select** the In This List link. **Select** the Printable button and then **File-Print** from the Web browser.

Step 11: To clear your *My List*, **select** In This List and **click** the remove all button.

To Access EBSCO Publishing

(Accessible Inside and Outside JUSD)

Step 1: Launch Internet Explorer

Step 2: Open the JUSD home page:
<http://www.jusd.k12.ca.us>

Step 3: Point to Online Resources and **Select** Library Resources, then **Click** on Online Database EBSCO Publishing and **Select** the EBSCO Online Research link

Step 4: Type in your school's EBSCO User ID and Password (contact your school librarian or email pford@jusd.k12.ca.us)

Step 5: Select the appropriate level Research Center as the research service.

Step 6: Type in your search criteria in the Find field and **click** on the Search button.

Step 7: In the results list **select** the article you wish to view.

Step 8: To add an article to a folder, **click** the Add link under the folder icon.

Step 9: To locate the images that were found in your search, **select** the Filter Results by Photos

To Access World Book Online

(Accessible Inside and Outside JUSD)

Step 1: Launch Internet Explorer

Step 2: Open the JUSD home page:
<http://www.jusd.k12.ca.us>

Step 3: Point to Online Resources and **Select** Library Resources, then **Click** on Online Encyclopedia World Book and **Select** the World Book Online link

Step 4: Type in your school's World Book Login ID and Password (contact your school librarian or email pford@jusd.k12.ca.us)

Step 5: Type in your search criteria in the appropriate search box. **Select go.**

Step 6: Select the article you wish to view from the results list.

Step 7: To navigate the article, **select** on a link from the Article Contents or Related Information.

World Book Online (WBO) also provides an Atlas and Surf the Ages feature. These features are available from the WBO home page.
