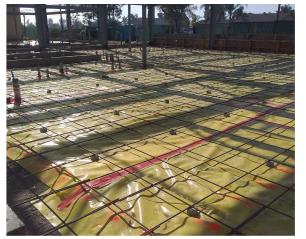

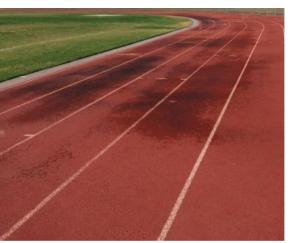

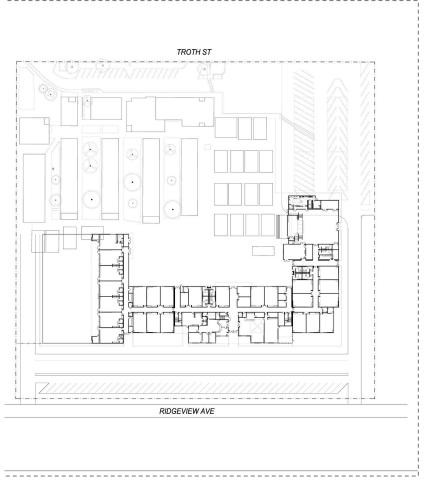


Troth Street ES Modernization Project - Schematic Design

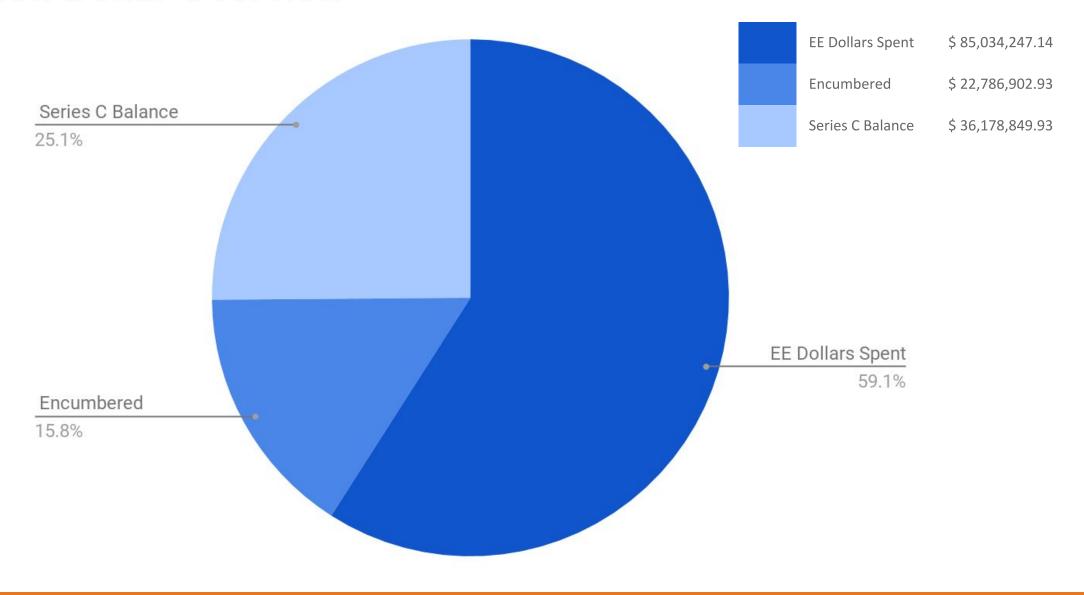

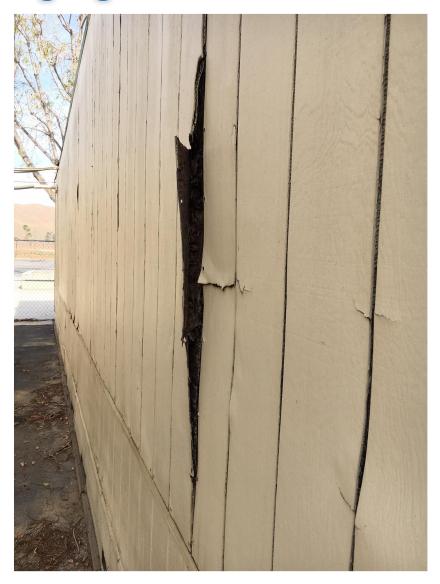






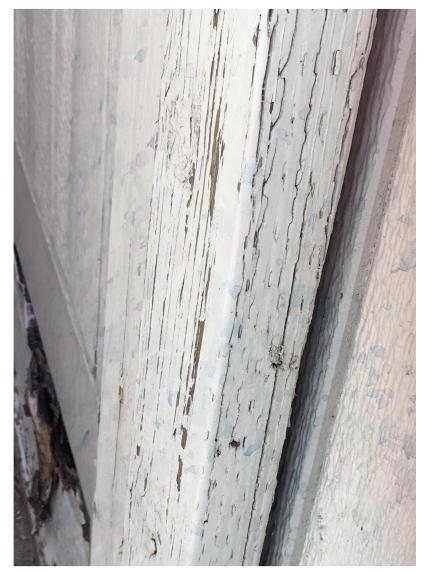


Aging Portables Districtwide (Approximately 200 Classrooms are Currently in Portables)

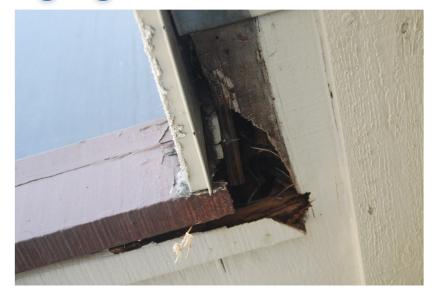








Aging Exteriors & Windows Districtwide

Aging Interiors Districtwide





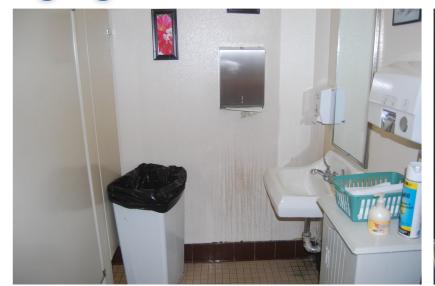

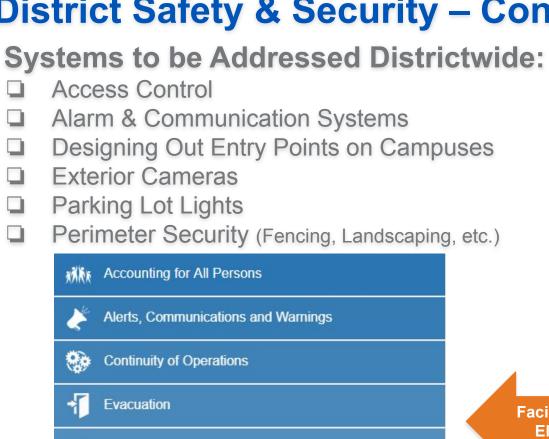
