



> The # of Students Failing and NOT Graduating was Growing


Academic Failure Was Increasing in Every Core Subject

11th Grade Students


12 Grade Students

"At-risk" to Graduate Can Be Identified <u>BEFORE</u> High School

- 1. GPA: Cumulative and 8th grade
- 2. # of Ds/Fs received in middle school
- 3. Test Scores

* NOT Behavior

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AAA provides----A Smaller learning environment:

- 25 students vs. 38 per classroom
- Individual attention everyday

AAA provides... Accelerated learning

- Students can earn 85 credits freshman year


