The first, on their own campus, takes place at 9:00 a.m. Seniors then will participate in a campus walk at Mission Middle School at 2:30 p.m. that afternoon. Both events are meant to inspire younger peers to keep working toward graduation.

Sunnsyslope Elementary School has invited graduating alumni to a "Senior Clap Out" event at their campus at 1:15 PM on May 22.
