High School Voter Registration Weeks take place during the last two weeks of April and September. The purpose is to promote civic engagement among California's youth and encourage those eligible to register to vote.

During Thursday's visit, Secretary Weber will share a message about the importance of voting and being engaged in our community and government. Eligible students also will have an opportunity to fill out voter registration cards or to pre-register to vote.
