The first-ever event will showcase the wide variety of career pathways available and allow students to explore future possibilities.

The event will take place in the Patriot High School gym in two sessions. Seniors will attend from 9:30-10:30 a.m. and juniors will participate from 11:00 a.m. to noon. Students from all JUSD high schools will participate.

Representatives from more than 40 industry partners and career technical training programs are expected to attend. Participants include representatives from multiple industries, including construction, manufacturing, engineering, technology, healthcare, the automotive industry, and more.

In addition, students will have the opportunity to meet representatives from community colleges, trade schools, apprenticeship programs, and workforce development agencies.

Jurupa Unified departments, including Maintenance and Operations, Transportation, Nutrition Services, Education-Information Technology, and the JUSD Print Shop also will participate.
