Jurupa Unified School District CHDP Physical Program

Jurupa Unified School District requires a CHDP, (Child Health and Disability Prevention), physical for children entering into kindergarten and first grade.

- The kindergarten physical must be dated no earlier than six (6) months before the first day of school.
- The first grade physical must be dated within the eighteen (18) months before the first day of school.
- The kindergarten physical will be counted as the first grade physical the next school year.
- Parents may take their child to any doctor who participates in the CHDP program.
- The physical must be a CHDP program physical.
- Physicals from a state other than California cannot be used.

The CHDP physical is a special physical exam designed to identify health issues that could cause a disability in the future or problems in school. The State Department of Health Services requires doctors to check for anemia, exposure to lead and many other potential problems. The State of California provides funds so that the physical is affordable to everyone. Read the brochure from the Department of Health Services or ask your medical provider for details.
