#### **HISTORY**

- Healthy School Initiative began in Marketing-February 2017 with two school districts in San Bernardino County
- Expanded in 2023 through the Student Behavioral Health Incentive Program

#### **OBJECTIVES**

- · Provide targeted on-site and at home support
- Respond to LEA requests for support and student assistance
- Support the child and family system with primary and secondary needs
- · Identify and close gaps in care
- To empower, support and educate members (and non-members) access to physical, behavioral health and community services
- Promote appropriate and timely utilization of health care services


#### **OUTCOMES**

- · Enhanced partnership with schools and staff
- Care gap closures (well child visits, immunizations- combo 2, depression screenings, asthma remediation, topical fluoride)
- Student/family needs met through
  - linkage to services and community resources
  - utilization of health plan benefits
- Achievement of positive health outcomes through trust building, resulting in increased adoption of health behaviours



# Health Navigators Who are we?

- Community Health Worker Certified with additional extensive training in working with and supporting the needs of local educational agencies
- Field based, meeting members and families where they feel most comfortable
- Have <u>lived experience</u> and expertly build trust within the <u>whole</u> family system
- Focus on health navigation, linkage to community-based organizations, medical specialists, BH services, community and health plan resources
- Provide on site support to Local Educational Agencies (LEAs/School Districts)



# Health Navigators' Scope

#### **Members**

- Health Navigation & Access to Care
- Education on preventive pediatric mental and physical health care
- Presentations including and not limited to:
  - ✓IEHP Benefit Overview
- √ Healthcare Navigation (medical, behavioral health, dental, vision)
- ✓ Asthma 101
- Connection to Health Plan and physicians based on need
- Coordination of care within internal IEHP departments
- Linkage to community resources

#### **Non-Members**

- Enrollment Assistance
- Direct linkage to primary insurance if necessary
- Connection to Community Based Organizations based on need

#### **Schools**

- Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training (ASIST)
- IEHP Benefit Overview training for school admin/staff
- Event Participation (Back to School, Parent Night events, Mental Health awareness month etc.)
- Meeting attendance (SARB, SART, IEP, etc.)
- Closed loop care coordination

#### **Community Partners**

- Capacity building with Community Based Organizations (CBOs) partners
- Presentations
- Initiative focused pilots and Programs



# Addressing Social Determinants of Health (SDOH)

The non-medical factors that influence health outcomes. They are the conditions in which people are born, grow, work, live, and age, and the wider set of forces and systems shaping the conditions of daily life.



Health, Well-Being, Functioning, Quality-of-Life Outcomes and Risks



# Enrollment Assistance

IEHP's Enrollment Advisor Team is the first step for community members to receive assistance with obtaining benefits with:

- IEHP Manages health coverage for persons with Medi-Cal and Medicare
- Medi-Cal Free health coverage for all ages who qualify
- Medicare Health coverage for persons 65+ and those with qualifying disabilities
- SSI Monetary assistance for disabled or low-income adults and children
- **SSDI** –Monetary assistance for disabled adults
- Covered California Low-cost health coverage for individual who do not qualify for Medi-Cal.

# **Examples of when to refer?**

- Any situation related to physical, mental or social needs, that impacts a student's learning, behaviors and/or attendance in school
- Social Determinants of Health support for a family
- Families that need help navigating & understanding health care system and benefits
- Children/parents in need of health care coordination or mental health coordination
- Children who need immunizations
- Children who are in need of well child exams, dental exams, vision exam
- Parents reporting that they are having a difficult time accessing appointments or getting requested referrals
- Parents who need help applying for health care coverage
