

# How to Use ParentConnection

## WELCOME, PARENTS!

This document will help you find and log on to Q ParentConnection and walk you through some of the features that make ParentConnection a great way to track your student's progress and help them continue to excel in the Jurupa Unified School District. You can access all your students through this one account. ParentConnection is also available as a mobile app from the Google and Apple Stores.

## MINIMUM COMPUTER REQUIREMENTS

You can access ParentConnection with the following minimum system requirements. Any one of the following web browsers:

- Apple Safari (Mac OS only) version 13.x
- Google Chrome version 83.x
- Microsoft Edge (Chromium) version 83.x
- Mozilla Firefox version 77.x
- (For mobile app) Android version 10.0
- (For mobile app) iOS version 12.0

## FINDING PARENTCONNECTION & LOGGING IN


### Step 1

To access ParentConnection go to [www.jurupausd.org](http://www.jurupausd.org) and click on the **ParentConnect** link at the top of the page. Alternatively, you may go directly to the ParentConnection homepage by entering the following web address in your internet browser: <https://q.jusd.k12.ca.us/Live/ParentPortal/>

The ParentConnection welcome page will appear.

### Step 2

Enter your pin or email address and password, and then click **Log In**.




## CHANGING YOUR PASSWORD

**IMPORTANT: First time users, change your password!** If this is your first time accessing ParentConnection the first thing you should do after logging in is to change your password.

### Step 1


Click on **My Account** at the top right of the page. The ParentConnection Login Information page appears.



### Step 2

- Enter your **Current Password** for authentication.
- Type in your **New Password**.
- Type in the password again in the **Confirm Password** field.
- Click the **Submit** button to submit your changes.

The **Updates Complete** message will briefly appear in green if the information was submitted successfully.



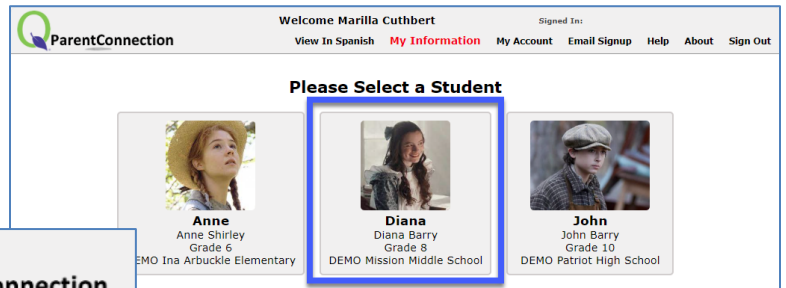
### Step 3

Click **Return to ParentConnection** to go to the student overview screen.

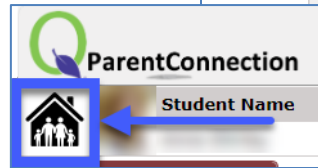
# USING PARENTCONNECTION

## Step 1

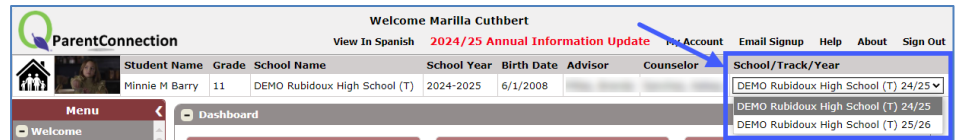
Choose your student by clicking the graphical tile that contains the student's picture, name, grade, and school. If you have more than one student in the district they will appear on this screen.



The Home icon will return you to the student selection screen.



Note: Towards the later part of the year you may notice an option to select a different school year for your student. This is due to district preparations for the next school year.

**Links** – Links to relevant websites made available by the district appear here.

**Welcome** – A welcome message.

**Accounts** – View student fines and fees and make online payments.

**Activities** – View and track student participation in activities (if entered at the school).

**Assigned Forms** – Review and complete school forms.

**Assignments** – Lets you view your student's progress. Click on "Show All" in the upper-right corner to view all assignments. Items in red are missing assignments.

**Attendance** – Contains information about your student's attendance.

**CAASPP Alt Assessment Report** – Lists CAASPP alternative assessment results.

**Cafeteria** – View student's current balance and make payments.

**Contacts** – View contact information including parent/legal guardian and emergency contacts.

You may wish to review this screen to ensure that the school has the most up-to-date information.

**Demographics** – Contains demographic data on your student. You may wish to review this screen to ensure that the school has the most up-to-date information.

**Documents** – Contains student documents such as transcripts if available.

**Enrollment** – View your student's enrollment history.

**GPA** – Lists your student's calculated overall GPA.

**Grad Rqmnts** – View your student's progress on their high school graduation requirements.

**Health** – Lists health information on file such as immunizations and health office visits.

**Library Items Out** – Lists library items checked out.

**Outstanding Fines** – Lists outstanding fines and balances.

**Programs** – Lists your student's participation in programs.

**Pulse** – View your student's overall progress at a glance.

**Marks** – Contains progress report marks that are posted during the school year.

**Report Cards** – Contains report cards.

**Schedule** – View your student's current class schedule.

**Standards** – View standards-based report card marks (elementary).

**Testing** – View standardized testing results.

**Transcript** – View transcript records for your student.

**News** – View internal schoolwide and class announcements (if available).

**Intra-District Transfer Status** – Check the status of an intra-district transfer request for your student.
