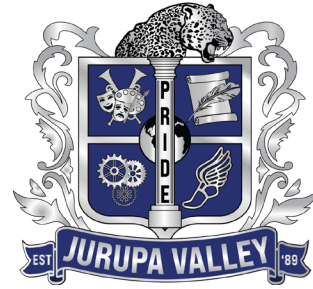

Jurupa Valley High School **Hall of Fame** **Nomination Packet**



Criteria and Eligibility

Article V: Eligibility and Criteria for Selection

Section 1. Nominees to the Jurupa Valley High School Hall of Fame shall be selected based upon set eligibility and criteria requirements. The Committee shall uphold these requirements and exceptions may only be made in extraordinary circumstances by a three-fourths majority of the Committee.

Section 2. Nominees shall fall into one of four (4) categories recognized by the JVHS Hall of Fame: Alumni, Athletics, Faculty/Staff, and Community. A nominee may only be selected to one (1) category of the JVHS Hall of Fame. Alumni shall be defined as having graduated from Jurupa Valley. Athletics shall be defined as the athletes and coaches involved in varsity athletics at Jurupa Valley. Faculty/Staff shall be defined as having been employed at Jurupa Valley. Contributors shall be defined as others involved in the Jurupa Valley community that do not fit into the other categories.

Section 3. Nominees must have shown dedication and/or made significant contributions to the Jurupa Valley community and/or represented Jurupa Valley with dignity after leaving the school. Nominees must have upheld the integrity of the Jaguar P.R.I.D.E. (Persistence, Respect, Integrity, Diversity, Empowerment), both at Jurupa Valley and in the world. Nominees must have brought special recognition to themselves and/or Jurupa Valley due to successful endeavors.

Section 4. Alumni shall be considered based on contributions made to the Jurupa Valley community or in the world after Jurupa Valley. Contributions may have directly affected or reflected positively upon the Jurupa Valley community. Scholastic, community, personal, and professional accomplishments shall be considered. If a parent nominates his/her child for consideration, an additional non-related reference with close ties to the Jurupa Valley School community must be included with the nomination. Alumni shall become eligible for nomination six (6) years after graduation from Jurupa Valley.

Section 5. Athletes shall be considered based on achievements in their athletic endeavors at Jurupa

Valley and beyond. Athletes' accomplishments at Jurupa Valley and in any collegiate or professional endeavors shall be considered. In addition, athletes must have upheld the reputation of a student-athlete and fared well in the classroom and in the community. Athletes shall become eligible for nomination six (6) years after graduation from Jurupa Valley.

Section 6. Coaches shall be considered based on achievements in their coaching endeavors at Jurupa Valley and beyond. Coaches' accomplishments at Jurupa Valley and in any other coaching endeavors shall be considered. Coaches shall become eligible after being one (1) year removed from coaching a sport at Jurupa Valley.

Section 7. Faculty, staff, and administrators shall be considered based on contributions made to the Jurupa Valley community or the world. Contributions may have directly affected or reflected positively upon the Jurupa Valley community. Faculty, staff, and administrators shall become eligible after retiring from Jurupa Valley with any number of years of service and being one (1) year removed from employment at Jurupa Valley.

Section 8. Contributors shall be considered based on extraordinary contributions made to the Jurupa Valley High School for the betterment of students, staff, and others involved in the community. Contributors shall be eligible at any time.

Section 9. In lieu of selecting all individual members of a group the Committee feels should be recognized in the JVHS Hall of Fame, the Committee may select the group as a whole. Groups shall be selected according to the same criteria above. Individuals included in a group shall be eligible to be selected as an individual if he/she meets eligibility requirements. Groups shall be eligible at any time.

Nomination Process By-Laws - Governing the Nomination Process

Article VI: Nomination Process

Section 1. Nominations shall be open to the Jurupa Valley community, including students, staff, alumni, parents, and city residents. Nominations shall be opened during a time frame between March and May each school year.

Section 2. The Committee shall be responsible for publicizing the nomination process and creating nomination packets. These packets shall include a cover letter with an overview of the Jurupa Valley High School Hall of Fame, the Committee, and other pertinent information. Packets shall be made available at Jurupa Valley's main office and on the JVHS website.

Section 3. The nomination form shall include information about the nominator (name, contact information, relationship to the Jurupa Valley community) and nominee (name, biographical

information, recommendation for nomination). No anonymous nominations shall be allowed. If a parent nominates his/her child for consideration, an additional non-related reference with close ties to the Jurupa Valley School community must be included with the nomination (*added in March 2018*). Nominees must meet all eligibility and criteria requirements to be considered by the Committee.

Section 4. There shall be no limit to the number of nominations a single person may make. A person may nominate himself/herself. A nominee needs to garner only one nomination to be considered by the Committee. There shall be no limit to the number of times a nominee may be nominated.

Section 5. The Committee shall review all nominations at a meeting before the end of March. Upon reviewing nominations, the Committee may nominate additional nominees at its discretion.

Voting Process By-Laws Governing the Voting Process

Article VII: Voting Process

Section 1. Upon completing its review of nominations, the Committee shall create a final ballot. To be included on the ballot, a nominee must have been nominated by either a member of the Jurupa Valley community or a member of the Committee, and have been seconded by a member of the Committee.

Section 2. Ballots shall be distributed by the chairperson of the Committee to all members of the Committee immediately following the review of the nominations by the Committee. Ballots shall be counted by the chairperson of the Committee and the result shall be announced by late May.

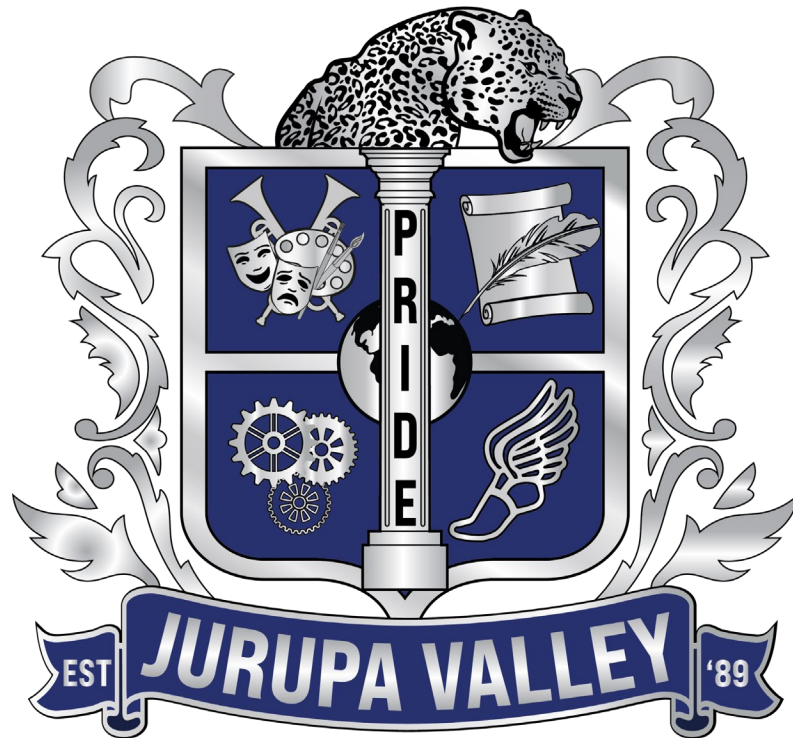
Section 3. Each voter may cast up to three (3) votes in an election. Votes may only be cast for nominees listed on the final ballot.

Section 4. A voter shall not vote for any nominee that may constitute a direct conflict of interest (i.e. voting for himself/herself, a relative, or a group of which the voter is a member). The voter shall abstain one of the allowed three (3) votes and the total possible votes for each candidate shall be adjusted based on abstentions.

Section 5. To be elected to the JVHS Hall of Fame, a nominee must 1.) receive the highest percentage of votes in an election or 2.) be in the top three (3) highest percentile of vote-getters and be named on more than fifty (50) percent of ballots cast. In the election, the top three (3) vote-getters shall be elected.

Section 6. Nominees who are in the top three (3) highest percentile of votes but are not elected to the JVHS Hall of Fame shall be automatically re-nominated by the Committee in the following year.

Section 7. The Principal of Jurupa Valley shall hold veto power over any inductee voted into the JVHS Hall of Fame by the Committee. This veto power shall be used when the Principal is privy to information about a candidate that renders the candidate unworthy of being inducted into the JVHS Hall of Fame.



Jurupa Valley High School Hall of Fame Nomination Form

To nominate a candidate for the Jurupa Valley High School Hall of Fame, please complete the following form. Incomplete forms will not be considered. Check the criteria and eligibility

requirements before nominating a candidate. Ineligible nominees will not be considered.

Note: Alumni shall become eligible for nomination six (6) years after graduation from Jurupa Valley. Staff members who have retired from Jurupa Valley, and coaches no longer coaching at Jurupa Valley are eligible. All contributors, community members, and groups are eligible.

The JVHS Hall of Fame Committee will consider all nomination forms if fully completed. **Include as much detail as possible; do not be modest.** Only one nomination is required for the Committee to consider a candidate. You may nominate multiple candidates, but a separate form must be completed for each. You may nominate yourself. No anonymous nominations are allowed.

Please submit all nominations by **August 4** for a Fall nomination consideration. Any nominations submitted after June will be considered the following year.
