JVHS will not replace caps that are damaged during decorating. Once the cardboard is decorated use double-sided velcro tape to attach the board to the cap.

Final Notes

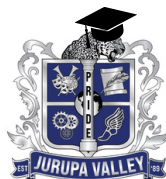

Final review and approval will be conducted prior to entering the gym before graduation.

Failure to follow the guidelines will result in confiscation of the cap prior to the ceremony. A plain replacement cap will be provided in return.
