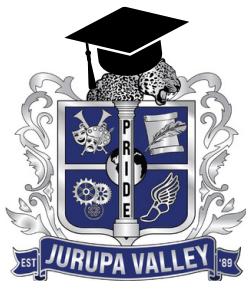
Graduation Guidelines: Cap Adornments

Congratulations Class of 2026! This year, JVHS will support the decoration of caps for the commencement ceremony. We want this experience for our graduates to be a positive and celebratory event of self-expression. We encourage seniors to be creative as they decorate their cap while strictly adhering to all guidelines.

Guidelines:

- Graduates are not allowed to decorate their gown. Only the graduation cap may be decorated.
- Only the flat top of the JVHS/Jostens issued cap may be decorated. No 3D embellishments **that may obstruct viewing** are allowed and decorations may not extend beyond the border of the cap.
- Decorations shall not interfere with the attachment of the tassel to the button on top of the cap and decorations may not hang off the sides of the cap.
- Caps must comply with the Student Code of Conduct at JVHS. No advertisements, symbols, words, or slogans conveying messages that may be deemed inappropriate.
- Any decoration that denotes an affiliation with gangs, drugs, violence, illegal activity, or disruptive behavior is prohibited. Caps must not threaten the safety of others or include hate speech of any kind. Obscene, profane or vulgar language is prohibited. Caps may not include numbers other than the graduation year (unless approved).
- The cap may not make noise. No bells, horns, or noisemakers of any kind. Additionally, the cap may not have lights, blinking lights, lasers, or moving parts; nothing battery operated. No use of duct tape as the main decoration.
- No nicknames (unless approved). No boyfriend/girlfriend names.
