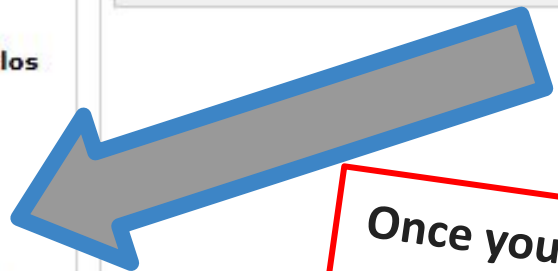

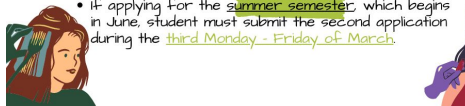


Step 1 - Submit RCC Application

Step 2 - Supplemental Application - MyPortal

- If applying for the **Fall semester**, which begins in August, student must submit the second application during the **third Monday - Friday of June**.
- If applying for the **spring semester**, which begins in January, student must submit the second application during the **third Monday - Friday of October**.
- If applying for the **summer semester**, which begins in June, student must submit the second application during the **third Monday - Friday of March**.



Steps to RIVERSIDE CITY COLLEGE

✓ APPLY TO RIVERSIDE CITY COLLEGE

If you're interested in starting your educational journey or continuing after skipping the fall or spring semester go to www.rcc.edu and submit an application. Processing of your application takes one to two business days. After processing, you will receive a welcome email containing a student ID number, student email address and instructions for [MyPortal](#).

✓ APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID

Paying for college can be expensive but there is help, go to www.FAFSA.gov or Dream Act www.CS&C.CA.gov to apply for financial aid. RCC school code is 001270.

✓ LOG INTO MYPORTAL

Sign in using YOUR RCC student email address. The default password is the first initial of your first name in uppercase and the first initial of your last name in lowercase with your six-digit date of birth.

✓ COMPLETE THE ONLINE ORIENTATION OR SUBMIT COLLEGE TRANSCRIPTS

First-time college students must complete orientation through [MyPortal](#) (under the heading entitled Academic Planning). It is important to complete this step as soon as possible.

• Please note: if you have completed a class at another institution and would like credit for the course, please submit a transcript from any previous colleges and a Prerequisite Validation Form that is available from the Counseling department.

✓ REVIEW SEMESTER EDUCATIONAL PLAN AND REGISTER FOR CLASSES

A few days after completing the orientation, new students can review the Semester Educational Plan through [MyPortal](#). The Semester Educational Plan provides guidance on what classes to take in your first semester. Enroll any time after your registration appointment. Registration appointments are available through [MyPortal](#) six to eight weeks before the start of the semester.

ROLLMENT FEES AND PARKING PERMIT (IF NEEDED)

nd fees are paid through [MyPortal](#) or at the Cashier's Office in person; the located on the first floor of the Dr. Charles A. Kane Student Services Building. permits are purchased through [MyPortal](#) and metered parking is available for mts.

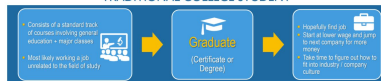

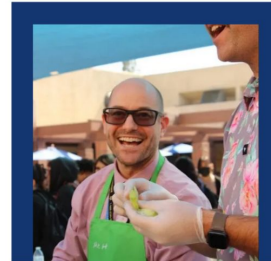

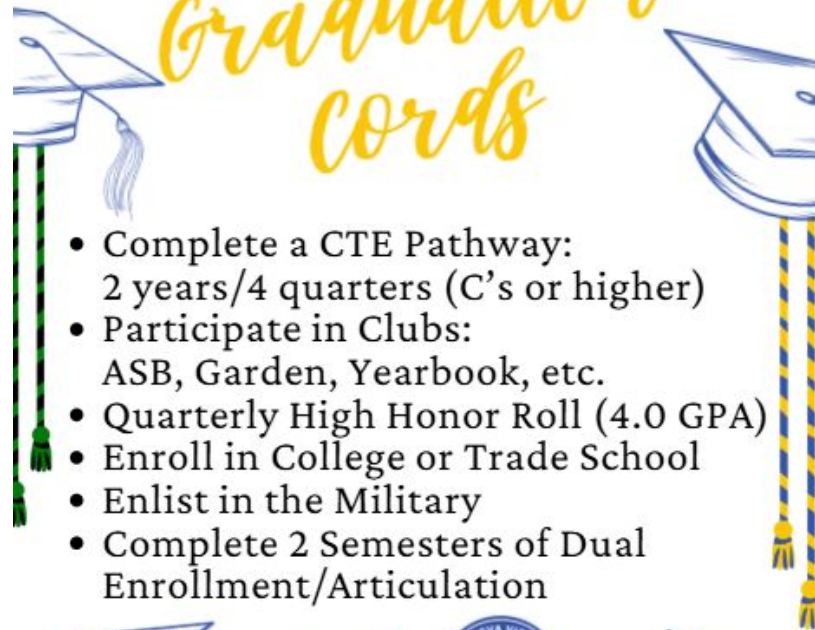
