Remember:

- Be sure you **check your college email every day**. This is how you will receive important information and updates.
- Norco College and RCC classes start the week of August 24. It's important that you are logged on to your classes on time, especially for the first class.
- Your instructors will let you know if the course will operate synchronously (which means your class will run "live" online during the scheduled meeting times), asynchronously (which means you can log on to your class at the times that work best for you), or as a combination of these two models. Look for notifications on your Canvas class page or in an email from your instructor.
- On the Canvas starting/home page for each course, you should find a link with information on library resources and on virtual tutoring support.
- It's important that you have actually registered online for your college class. You will not be added to the Canvas system until you do this and this must be completed by the end of the first week of classes. If you still need assistance with this, please email the following people:

Getting Started with Canvas (RCCD's Learning Management System)

- Canvas serves the same function as Power School does here in JUSD. It has many similar functions, but every system has its own unique features and operations. It is important to get familiar with Canvas before classes start so you are comfortable using this platform.
