

Welcome Back Rustic Lane Families!!!

We are getting ready to start the 22-23 school year and we are excited! I wanted to share important information with you as we start to get closer to the first day of school. There is a lot of information in this communication but my goal is to give you everything in one place to easily access if you need to come back to it.

**First Day of School-** Monday, August 8th. There will be NO minimum day the first week of school.

**New start time-** Due to the new legislation that requires high schools to start later, we have had to adjust our schedule to start just a bit earlier. Our regular school day will be from 7:55-2:15. Instruction will start at 7:55, students will line up on the playground at 7:50 to walk to their classes. TK and Kindergarten will be released at 11:15 everyday. Students will be allowed to enter campus at 7:15, students may not be dropped off prior to 7:15 as there is no supervision at this time. **Classroom Assignments-** Teacher assignments will be available to view in ParentConnect Friday, August 5th after 4pm.

**Annual Information Update (AIU)-** Please complete the AIU as soon as possible. This is where you will be able to update your emergency contact information, health information and general contact information. This is required to be completed in Parent Connect. We do have to follow up with you if this is not completed. If you need your PIN please call our office for support.

**Pick up/Drop-off/Transportation-** We will continue to utilize our front parking lot as a drive through drop off option, entering on Rustic Lane exiting on Rathke. Please do not release your student from your vehicle until you have reached the crosswalk. You may also drop off students along Rathke, students should only cross the street at the designated crosswalks. Stobbs will not be an entry/exit point for students, we have had increased concerns for the safety of our students. Please make arrangements for students to enter and exit campus from Rustic Lane or Rathke. If you believe your student will qualify to ride our general education school bus due to the distance you live from the school you may click this link to apply for a bus pass at no cost.
