To Our AP Students and Parents:

ALL AP students should be working with their AP teacher(s) to help prepare for this year's exams. Be sure to check your JUSD and AP emails often.

All AP exams will be administered on line this year and are designed for students to be able to take these exams at home using a laptop, Chromebook, tablet or smartphone. Students will be able to type and upload their responses or hand write their responses and submit a photo via cell phone.

Most exams will be 45 minutes in length (with 5 additional minutes for uploading) with one or two freeresponse questions. Students will need to access the online testing system 30 minutes before testing is to begin to get set up.

Art and Design 2D, Art and Design 3D, Computer Science Principles, Seminar, Research and Drawing will use portfolio submissions and will not have a separate online exam. All deadlines for these submissions have been extended to May 26.

Students taking world language exams will complete two spoken tasks consistent with free response questions 3 and 4 on the current AP exam. Written responses will not be provided.
