



## 2019-20 Middle School Grade 7 Math Course Descriptions

### **Course Descriptions:**

#### **Math 7**

**Math 7 w/support:** This course is a two-hour, double-blocked class that engages students with the Math 7 standards while also providing additional instructional time for students needing extra support to be successful with Math 7 standards.

**Math 7 w/out support:** This course engages students with the Math 7 standards during a regular class period with no additional, scheduled support.

#### **Accelerated Math 7**

This is a very advanced/rigorous course. The Middle School Accelerated Program is a “compacted” version of the Integrated Mathematics pathway where students complete all Math 7, Math 8, and Mathematics I (3 years of math) standards in 2 years. Accelerated Math 7 focuses on the completion of all Math 7 standards, while also integrating many of the Math 8 standards into the curriculum. The intent of this course is to prepare students for Mathematics I in grade 8. (*Common Core State Standards for Mathematics, Appendix A, Page 3*).

**Grade 6 Math Achievement — Meet TWO of the criteria:**

- Teacher Recommendation (consistent scores of 1 - 2 on report card)
- CAASPP score of 1 or 2
- Math diagnostic test qualifying score
