Agriculture and Natural Resources

Agriscience Pathway

California produces almost 50% of all fruits and vegetables in the US and 14% of agricultural revenue. In this pathway students learn about the future of sustainable agriculture and resource management. The pathway includes a-g courses.

Arts, Media and Entertainment

Design, Visual and Media Arts Pathway

Students in this pathway learn about technical arts and how they can use their creativity in a digital, engineering or product design career. The pathway includes a-g and college articulated courses.

Building and Construction Trades

Residential and Commercial Construction Pathway

The construction industry is a major employer in the Inland Empire and the state. It offers you the opportunity to design, build and create. Students learn about environmentally sustainable construction and alternative energies in the BITA (Building Industry Technology Academy) program.

Engineering and Architecture

Engineering Design Pathway

This pathway prepares students for careers in engineering by figuring out how things work and how to find practical uses for scientific discoveries to solve everyday and complex problems.

Manufacturing and Product Development

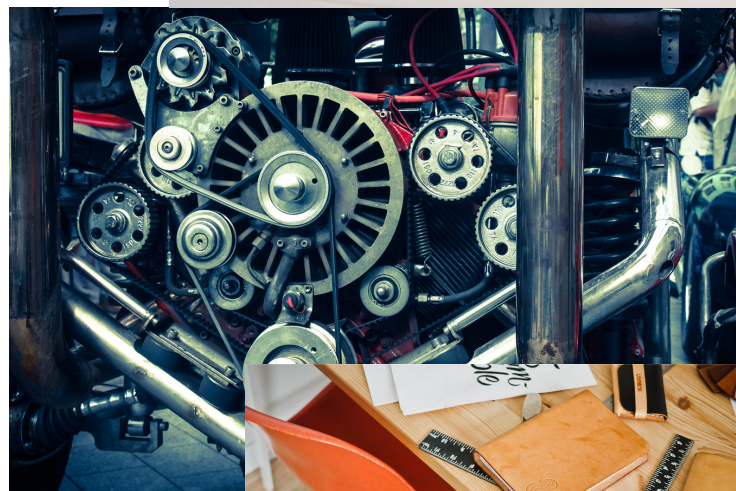
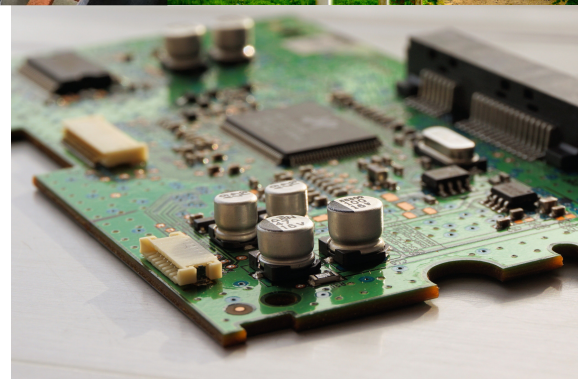
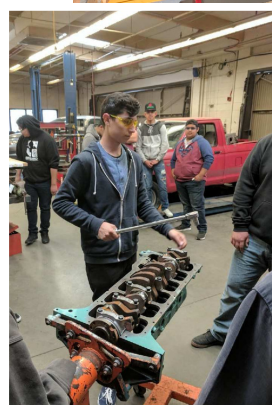
Product Innovation and Design Pathway

Diagnostics, Service and Repair Pathway

Students in this pathway learn how to diagnose and repair all major automotive systems, including those found in alternative fuel vehicles. Courses in the pathway offer articulated college credit.

Arts, Media and Entertainment

Design, Visual and Media Arts Pathway

Students learn how to put their creativity to work. Literally. Students learn how digital media is used to design and market products across industries as they develop skills in print and broadcast media and production. The pathway offers a-g and college articulated courses.

Fashion and Interior Design

Fashion Design & Merchandising Pathway

Fashion design is big business in California -- not only for consumers, but to support the entertainment industry. Students learn about the art of fashion, design and marketing. The pathway includes a-g coursework.

Health Science and Medical Technology

Patient Care Pathway

Health Care = science and compassion at work. Our program has two areas of focus: sports medicine and emergency medicine. Students can work as student athletic trainers and can earn their EMR certification at no cost. The pathway includes a-g courses.

Structural Repair and Refinishing Pathway

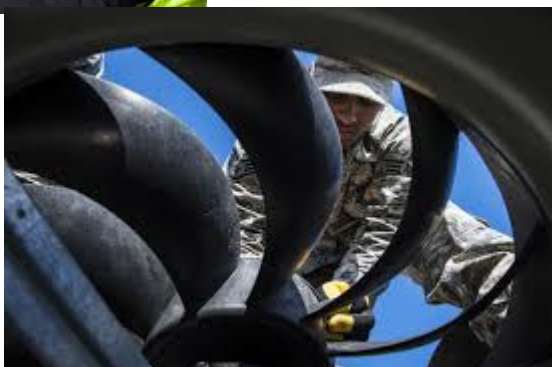
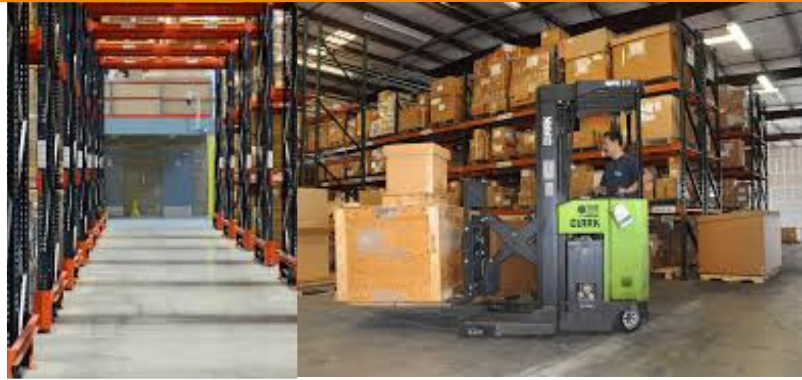

Transportation Operations Pathway
